## **BREATHE IN**

the fresh alpine air



At 2,509 m, the Timmelsjoch High Alpine Road ranks among the highest paved passes in Europe. Even in June, you may still see metre-high walls of snow along the road. At the top of the pass, the extent of the panorama is as impressive as the mountain air is refreshing. If you want to stop off for a break, Rasthaus Timmelsjoch serves hot meals all day. Hikers and climbers will be in their element in the surrounding Ötztal and Stubai Alps. You can also walk along the original path over the pass (E5) like the smugglers back in the olden days.

Ötztal Card: Holders of the Ötztal Card can use the Timmelsjoch High Alpine Road free of charge when travelling on the local bus.

## Important information – limited permission for traffic

In accordance with the current Italian regulations, only cars and motorcycles are permitted to travel on the Italian side of the pass road. Mobile homes, small buses and lorries with a max. gross weight of 8 tons, max. width of 2.55 m and max. height of 4 m are also permitted. Buses and lorries with a length of over 4.5 m are not permitted. The total length of the towing vehicle and the trailer must not exceed 10 m.
